Adds and updates definitions to satisfy current industry practice needs; aligns and remedies inconsistencies between chapters 438 and 439, Hawaii Revised Statutes; removes the five-year license requirement for barber and beauty operator Board of Barbering and Cosmetology member seats; raises fees for penalties and disciplinary actions; and removes medical clearance requirements. CPN **SB 3083** Authorizes the Commissioner of Financial Institutions Status & (Commissioner) to modify or waive requirements in chapter Testimony 454M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to implement changes and improvements made to the NMLS. **SB 3084** RELATING TO THE ELEVATOR MECHANICS LICENSING CPN BOARD COMPOSITION. Status & Amends the composition of the Elevator Mechanics Licensing **Testimony** Board to replace the ex-officio Department of Labor and Industrial Relations member with a licensed elevator mechanic member.
