SB 2329 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICES. Establishes that charging shipping and delivery charges that exceed the actual cost to ship or deliver a commodity to a consumer in Hawaii constitutes an unfair and deceptive practice.	CPN
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CABARET LICENSES. Prohibits the issuance of cabaret licenses to premises located within the apartment mixed use subprecinct Waikiki special district.	CPN
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE VALUATION. When identifying a replacement vehicle or cash settlement value, requires an insurer to take into consideration costs of shipping the vehicle and the insured's travel for pre-purchase inspection of the replacement vehicle, if not on the same island, and, if the insured vehicle is an electric vehicle, the remaining battery life and capacity of the vehicle's primary battery, known as the traction battery pack, which shall have equal or greater weight than mileage on the vehicle.	CPN
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS. Requires condominium associations to allow members or their proxies to vote by mail and attend and cast votes in association meetings through the internet, teleconference, or other electronic transmission technology. Ensures the provision of copies of printed audit trails.	CPN

RELATING TO COMMON INTEREST COMMUNITIES.

Prohibits planned community associations, condominium associations, or their boards of directors from expending association funds to enforce de minimis violations of association rules or regulations that do not pose risks to the health and safety of other members, units, or unit owners.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.
