HTH, CPN Requires that one annual mental health screening be included in Status & health insurance coverage for diagnosis and treatment of mental **Testimony** disorders. Effective 1/1/2050. (SD1) SB 2592, SD1 RELATING TO HEALTH. HTH, CPN Defines "clinical laboratory director" to include certain Status & physicians, licensed clinical laboratory scientists, and **Testimony** pharmacists. Amends the definition of "practice of pharmacy" to include the ordering and performing of certain Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments-waived tests. Effective 1/1/2050. (SD1) RELATING TO COVERAGE FOR MAMMOGRAPHY. HTH, CPN SB 2635, SD1 Requires insurers and mutual benefit societies to cover Status & mandated services for mammography at least as favorably as **Testimony** coverage for other radiological examinations. Effective 1/1/2050. (SD1) RELATING TO ACCESS TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SB 2645, SD1 HTH, CPN SERVICES. Status & Allows for standard telephone contacts for telehealth purposes **Testimony** related to behavior health services. Effective 1/1/2050. (SD1) RELATING TO MIDWIVES. SB 2661, SD1 HTH, CPN Establishes the Home Birth Task Force to investigate Status & outstanding issues relating to regulatory scheme created by Act **Testimony** 32, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019. (SD1) SB 2829, SD1 RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH. HTH, CPN Establishes provisional or associate level licensure requirements Status & for marriage and family therapists, mental health counselors, **Testimony** and psychologists and authorizes insurance reimbursements in certain circumstances. Allows psychologist license applicants to sit for the licensing examination before completing other

HTH/HWN, CPN Includes the use of traditional native Hawaiian burial practices in Status & the treatment and disposal of human remains, including the use Testimony of water cremation or alkaline hydrolysis. Requires alkaline hydrolysis facilities to be licensed by the Department of Health. Requires alkaline hydrolysis facility operators to be licensed and undergo alkaline hydrolysis operator training.
