SB 3107, SD1 RELATING TO THE RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD-TENANT HOU, CPN

(SSCR2474) (SSCR2474)

Allows a landlord, when processing an application to rent residential property, to charge an application screening fee up to a maximum of \$25 for the cost of requesting a tenant report or credit report for a potential tenant. Requires landlords to refund

any unused amount of the application screening fee and, upon request, provide a receipt of the fee and a copy of any report obtained via the screening process to the applicant. (SD1)
