Status & Testimony

Allows Department of Education students to fulfill world language, fine arts, or career and technical education graduation requirements with computer science. Establishes a scholarship at the University of Hawaii to encourage students majoring in education to take a computer science course. Requires UH to establish computer science pathways for students majoring in education. Requires teacher licensing and certification to

include computer science. Appropriates funds.

SB 2359 RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. HRE/EDU, WAM

Status & Testimony

Requires the University of Hawaii to establish in each county, K-12 expanded teaching cohort programs for students who are pursuing undergraduate degrees in education. Requires interim reports prior to the regular sessions of 2023, 2024, and 2025, and a final report prior to the regular session of 2026. Repeals

12/31/26.

RELATING TO CIVIL RIGHTS. **SB 2636** EDU/HRE, JDC Specifies additional forms of discrimination and other prohibited Status & conduct under Chapter 368D, HRS. Requires covered entities Testimony to adopt written policies and undertake other specified enforcement actions no later than 1/1/2023. Requires annual reports to Legislature. **SB 214** RELATING TO STUDENT JOURNALISM. EDU/HRE, JDC Establishes freedom of press protections for student journalists Status & producing school-sponsored media or university-sponsored Testimony media unless subject to certain exceptions.
