SB 2946, SD1 (HSCR1212-22) RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Agriculture for water source infrastructure and the maintenance and improvement to the Peekauai Ditch Irrigation System located on Kauai. Effective

SB 2480, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1331-22) **Status**

RELATING TO THE WAHIAWA IRRIGATION SYSTEM.

AGR, JHA, FIN

Requires the office of the governor to negotiate the State's fee simple acquisition of the Wahiawa irrigation system on the island of Oahu. Authorizes and appropriates moneys for the department of agriculture, agribusiness development corporation, and department of land and natural resources to purchase, repair, and maintain the Wahiawa irrigation system and the associated spillway. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)



SB 2473, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1209-22) Status

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

Amends the focus, scope, responsibilities, and powers of the Agribusiness Development Corporation. Amends the definition of the term "agriculture" as the term relates to the Agribusiness Development Corporation. Transfers the administrative attachment of the Agribusiness Development Corporation from the Department of Agriculture to the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism. Amends the requirements and responsibilities of the Board of Directors of the Agribusiness Development Corporation. Amends the required contents of the Hawaii agribusiness plan. Appropriates moneys. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)

SB 339, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1207-22) Status

RELATING TO THE IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LAND OUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL COST TAX CREDIT.

Extends the period during which the important agricultural land qualified agricultural cost tax credit is available. Applies to taxable years beginning after 12/31/2021. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)

SB 1297, SD1 (HSCR1217) **Status**

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST MAUIGROWN COFFEE, INC. Extends the authorization to issue special purpose revenue bonds to assist MauiGrown Coffee, Inc., with the operation and expansion of its

farm and mill. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)

SB 2960, SD1 (HSCR1206-22) Status

RELATING TO FOOD SAFETY.

Requires the Department of Agriculture to partner with the Hawaii agricultural community to establish and implement a food safety certification training program to help small to medium sized farms comply with federal food safety certification mandates. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)

SB 2990, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1215-22) Status

RELATING TO SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE.

Establishes a cover crop reimbursement pilot program to provide up to 75 per cent cost reimbursement to farming operations in the State for the acquisition of cover crop seeds, green manure, or compost. Requires the convening of a review panel to screen and rate applicants on the quality of their cover crop, green manure, and composting practices. Establishes a cover crop reimbursement pilot program manager position within the department of agriculture to administer the program. Requires reports to the legislature. Appropriates moneys. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)

SB 2992, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1270-22) **Status**

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

Establishes the Hawaii agricultural investment program to support local agricultural producers. Requires annual reports. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)

SB 2218, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1383-22) Status

RELATING TO A FOOD HUB PILOT PROGRAM.

Requires the department of agriculture to establish a five-year food hub pilot program to increase access to local food. Provides for the award of grant funding to qualified applicants wishing to establish or expand a food hub or provide certain technical assistance. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds for the Honalo marshalling yard. Requires reports to the legislature. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)

SB 346, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1137-22) Status	RELATING TO FARM ANIMALS. Effective 1/1/2028, makes it unlawful for farm owners or operators and business owners or operators to sell or offer for sale any shell egg in the State that is not USDA certified cage free, as evidenced by a USDA certified cage free grademark or shield. Exempts certain commercial table-egg layer premises. Establishes the cage free matching grant program until 6/30/2027. Establishes penalties. Requires DOA to establish rules. Appropriates funds. Repeals on 6/30/2032. (HD1)	AGR, FIN
SB 2195, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1208-22) Status	RELATING TO FOWL. Requires the department of agriculture to collaborate with the department of land and natural resources to establish a pilot program to manage the population of feral chickens in the State. Appropriates funds for the pilot program. Repeals 6/30/2028. (HD1)	AGR, FIN
SB 2907, SD1 (HSCR1385-22) Status	RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES. Requires the Hawaii Invasive Species Council to classify coffee leaf rust as an invasive species in its administrative rules and to direct available funding for mitigation efforts, research, and prevention or control actions for coffee leaf rust. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	AGR, FIN
SB 2621, SD1 (HSCR1384-22) Status	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE. Appropriates moneys to the Department of Agriculture to establish bovine tuberculosis control operations on Molokai, including staff, land, and equipment. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	AGR, FIN
SB 2996, SD1 (HSCR1386-22) Status	RELATING TO ANTS. Appropriates an unspecified sum to the Department of Land and Natural Resources (LNR402) for research, extension, and control of the little fire ant and other harmful ants. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	AGR, FIN
SB 3152, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1306-22) Status	MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. Makes an emergency appropriation to authorize additional funds for the department of transportation highways division's special maintenance program. (HD1)	TRN, FIN
SB 3121, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1229-22) Status	RELATING TO FUNDING FOR PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS. Establishes an accessible parking special account within the disability and communication access board special fund. Increases the state annual vehicle registration fee by \$1 and requires that \$1 from each annual vehicle registration fee be deposited into the accessible parking special account. Requires all costs associated with the statewide parking for persons with disabilities program to be appropriated from the accessible parking special account beginning July 1, 2023. SB 152, HD1 (HSCR1226-22) Status	RELATING TO CHILD PASSENGER RESTRAINTS. Amends requirements for the restraint of child passengers. RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

Establishes the electric bicycle and electric moped rebate program and subaccount to encourage the purchase and use of electric bicycles and electric mopeds. Allocates a portion of the barrel tax for the rebate

program. Effective 1/1/2050. (HD1)

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

Establishes long-term goals for zero emissions transportation in Hawaii

and abroad to reduce and eliminate transportation emissions. Establishes the interisland transportation working group. Requires annual reports to the legislature. Requires the department of transportation and Hawaii state energy office to prepare for and incentivize the increased adoption of electric vehicles in the State.

SB 2295, SD2, HD2 (HSCR1293-22) Status RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

Requires the department of transportation to plan for sea level rise in

all future or amended transportation projects. Requires all department of transportation highway, harbor, and airport projects to conform to certain carbon concrete standards except in certain circumstances.
