RELATING TO DENTAL ASSISTANTS.

Status & STestimony	Allows dental assistants to perform limited duties under general supervision of a dentist in public health settings.	
Status & 1 Testimony n	RELATING TO HEARING AIDS. Requires health insurance policies and contracts issued after 12/31/22 to provide coverage for the cost of hearing aids at a minimum of \$1,500 per hearing aid for each hearing-impaired ear every thirty-six months in their base plans.	HTH, CPN
Status & do	RELATING TO TOBACCO USE DISORDER TREATMENT. Requires facilities providing treatment for substance abuse disorders to assess a patient or client for use of all tobacco products at the time of their initial intake and take certain actions of the patient or client is determined to have a tobacco use disorder. Status & a	RELATING TO NURSES. Allows for temporary permits to be issued to registered nurses and licensed practical nurses from a territory or foreign country hat are seeking a state license by endorsement.	HTH, CPN/JDC
Status & property pro	RELATING TO HEALTH. Defines "clinical laboratory director" to include certain obysicians, licensed clinical laboratory scientists, and obarmacists-in-charge of pharmacies. RELATING TO HEALTH. **SB 2751** HTH, WAM Expands the Hawaii health corps program and Hawaii rural Status & health care provider loan repayment program to include Testimony incentives for psychologists and social workers. Makes the department of health responsible for administering the Hawaii rural health care provider loan repayment program. Appropriates funds. RELATING TO POOLS. HTH, JDC **SB 2804** For purposes of the Department of Health's authority to adopt Status & rules concerning public health and safety, defines "pool" to **Testimony** mean a watertight artificial structure containing a body of water that does not exchange water with any other body of water either naturally or mechanically used for swimming, diving, recreational bathing, or therapy by humans. **SB 2829** RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH. HTH, CPN Establishes provisional or associate level licensure requirements Status & for marriage and family therapists and psychologists and Testimony authorizes insurance reimbursements in certain circumstances. Allows psychologist license applicants to sit for the licensing examination before completing other requirements.
