Allows the Comptroller to direct the transfer records to the State Records Center and determine the time period after which the records shall be transferred as directed. Appropriates funds to the Department of Accounting and General Services for operating costs and equipment for the State Records Center

and two full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE) positions within the

Hawaii State Archives.
