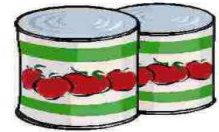

- Milk – Non-Fat Dry** 2 boxes (12 1-qt envelopes)
- Canned Meat, Poultry, Fish**
 - Tuna 2 cans
 - Beef Stew 2 cans
 - Chili with Beans 3 cans
 - Salmon 2 cans
 - Vienna Sausage 3 cans
 - Spam 3 cans
 - Corned Beef Hash 3 cans
 - Corned Beef 3 cans
 - Deviled Ham 3 cans
 - Pork and Beans 3 cans
 - Chunked Chicken 2 cans
 - Assorted Condensed Soups 6 cans
 - Condensed Cream of Mushroom Soup 3 cans
- Canned Fruits and Vegetables**
 - Assorted Fruits (peaches, pears, etc.) 12 cans
