

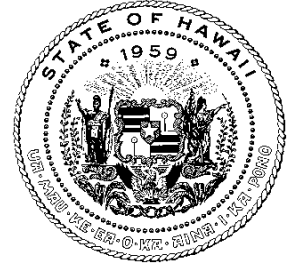

Funds Released for Salt Lake Elementary and Moanalua High School

Governor David Ige released \$6.4 million to address school improvements, upgrades, and renovations in District 32. Of these funds, the following amounts were appropriated for Salt Lake Elementary and Moanalua High School.

SALT LAKE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Renovation of Building E from a single "pod" classroom into four individual classrooms

Project Cost: \$1,400,000

MOANALUA HIGH SCHOOL

Design and construction funds to provide an auditorium facility for the Performing Arts Center

Project Cost: \$5,000,000

How to Check which 2015 Bills Passed the Legislature

A bill that successfully passes out of the Legislature will be sent to the Governor for consideration. To view a complete listing of all the measures that passed:

- Visit www.capitol.hawaii.gov
- Click on "Reports & Lists"
- Scroll down to "Legislature"
- Click on the link "Bills that Passed Legislature"

When a bill becomes a law, it is known as an Act. To view all 2015 Acts:

- Click on "Reports & Lists"
- Scroll under "Deadline Tracking" to "Governor's Actions"
- Click on "List of Acts"
- Click on the Act number to view the Governor's Message and legislation

2015 Legislative Timeline

MAY

May 1: Last day to file Fiscal bills to deck for Final Reading

May 7: Adjournment *sine die* (End of Session)

Governor's Deadlines

JUNE

June 29: Notice of Intent to veto deadline
(35th day after Adjournment *sine die*)

JULY

July 14: Veto Deadline
(45th day after Adjournment *sine die*)
