SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT

Aloha!

As the 2016 regular session came to a close, Senators, along with their House counterparts, highlighted the challenging issues that we addressed over the past several months. Each year we are faced with new challenges, the call for assistance, or to decide on policy that can shape an industry, the state for generations to come. The Legislature made significant progress in the areas of health, agriculture, and education.

AGRICULTURE

- \$1.35M for the master plan of the Whitmore Ag-Tech Park
- \$13M to upgrade and improve the Galbraith Irrigation System
- \$31.5M to purchase over 900 acres of agriculture land

COMMUNITY

- \$55,000 for the Whitmore Economic Development Group to develop an ag-tech innovation hub

EDUCATION

- \$100M for heat abatement at public schools statewide
- \$11.5M for a 15-classroom building at Mililani Middle School
- \$2M to construct a parking lot access and an ADA ramp at Mililani High School
- \$1.1M to plan a High Technology Workforce Development Center

HEALTH

- \$2.5M for the Wahiawa General Hospital
- \$700,000 for the Wahiawa Center for Community Health

TRANSPORTATION

- \$17M for construction and rehabilitation to the Kipapa Stream Bridge
- \$2.5M for the replacement of the Upper Stream Poamoho bridge

I want to thank you all for your support this legislative session and I look forward to our continued work through the interim.

*The Senate adjourns sine die for the 28th Legislative Session. During the final days before sine die, the Legislature passed **272 bills** which are now headed to the Governor for enactment. The Governor has until **July 12, 2016** to sign or veto legislation. Bills that are not acted upon will become law without the Governor's signature.*

- **\$17M** to rehabilitate or replace the Kipapa Stream Bridge
- **\$31M** to acquire 900 acres of land between Central Oahu and North Shore
