Public Schools Serving District 18 Families 2017 Priority Construction Projects

Elementary Schools

Kaleiopuu - \$275,000 for design for cafeteria expansion

Kanoelani - \$4 million for planning, design and construction of a portable classroom building, with a fire lane and hydrant

Kipapa - \$36,000 for renovations to the cafeteria stage and \$21,000 for upgrades to stage lighting; \$1 million for air conditioning in five buildings and portable classrooms

Mililani Waena – \$1 million to widen the driveway between the main parking lot and the cafeteria parking lot to create a turnaround area; \$200,000 for construction of a covered walkway over the driveway sidewalk; \$700,000 for construction of covered lanais between the library and the admin building and between the library and cafeteria; \$5 million to build a second floor for the library; \$500,000 for air conditioning remaining classrooms in Building D

Waikele - \$7 million for construction of a new, six-classroom building

Intermediate/Middle Schools

Waipahu Intermediate - \$22 million for construction of a new classroom building and equipment; \$3 million for additional playcourts and equipment

High Schools

Mililani - \$12 million to build a performance arts facility; \$3 million for improvements to Building A, including enclosing the courtyard and extending the building at the school entrance; \$1.2 million for equipment and improvements to the athletic field, including replacement of wooden bleachers

Waipahu High - \$15 million for construction of a new classroom building
