14 Pharmacy. He also was a Pharmacist at Harborview Medical Center in Seattle, Washington.

Dr. Sumida is active in the community. He volunteered for various COVID-19

vaccination clinics, health screenings and provided education throughout the State. He

currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Hawaii Pharmacists Association and is a 1 member of the American Society of Health System Pharmacists, American College of Clinical 2 Pharmacy, and American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy. He is also affiliated with 3 several professional organizations including the Hawaii Pharmacists Association, American 4 Society of Health System Pharmacists, American College of Clinical Pharmacy, and the 5 American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy. 6 He has earned numerous awards throughout his career. He is the recipient of the 7 Faculty Service Award at the Daniel K. Inouye College of Pharmacy, the Pharmacy Leadership 8 Award from the Hawaii Pharmacists Association, and the Kaiser Permanente Exceptional 9 Contribution Award in 2004. 10 Dr. Sumida has a Doctor of Pharmacy and a Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy from the 11 University of Washington, School of Pharmacy. 12 We ask for your support on the confirmation of Dr. Wesley Sumida, enabling him to 13 continue to serve on the Honolulu Subarea Health Planning Council. 14

I am a Professor at Daniel K. Inouye College of Pharmacy (DKICP) and a health economist. I have been a member of the advisory committee to HONSAC since 2011 and have served as the Vice Chair.
