RELATING TO PAYMENT OF CLAIMS OF THE UNCLAIMED PROPERTY PROGRAM

The Department of Budget and Finance supports House Bill No. 1020, which proposes to increase the amount of moneys that can be carried over at June 30 of each fiscal year by the Unclaimed Property Trust Fund from \$1,300,000 to \$2,500,000. This bill will permit the timely payment of claims filed with the Unclaimed Property Program.

Pursuant to section 523A-26 (d), HRS, all unencumbered and unexpended moneys in excess of \$1,300,000 remaining on balance in the Trust Fund on June 30 of each year lapses to the credit of the general fund. Consequently, the beginning balance at the start of the fiscal year for the Trust Fund is \$1,300,000.

Often times, claims waiting to be paid from the prior fiscal year exceed the \$1,300,000 opening balance hence payment of those claims are delayed. This bill will allow the timely payment of such claims at the beginning of the fiscal year.
