The Hawai'i State Council on Developmental Disabilities **supports HCR161/HR162**, which urges the Department of Transportation and the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu to construct elevated crosswalks along Meheula Parkway near Mililani High School.

Establishing safer and more visible pedestrian routes not only benefits students but other members of the community who use ground transportation, including those with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities. Safe and accessible walkways allow those with I/DD to have more freedom of travel and promote independence.
