REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE "MADE IN HAWAII" AND "HAWAII MADE" BRANDS AND PREPARE A PLAN TO ENCOURAGE AND ENFORCE THE USE OF THOSE BRANDS.

Chair Quinlan, Vice-Chair Holt and members of the Committee.

The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT) offers the following comments on HCR 84/HR 75, which is requesting the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to conduct a study on the "Made in Hawaii" and "Hawaii Made" brands and prepare a plan to encourage and enforce the use of those brands.

During last year's legislative session, \$150,000 was appropriated from ARPA funds to promote the "Hawaii Made" brand. A Request for Proposal was issued in January 2022, requesting services to conduct a study and to develop the brand. The RFP, however, did not yield any response. A revised Request for Proposal was again issued in March 2022, with a response due date in April.
