Aloha,

Thank you for considering SB2126, which we strongly urge to be passed for the health and quality of life of Hawaii residents. Studies increasingly detail the environmental health hazard posed by persistent noise pollution, with *intentional* and excessive loud vehicles a growing and pervasive cause in our State. Current fines are too low to provide much of a deterrent and are failing to make a dent in the growing problem. While we believe the proposed increased fines are still low, especially given that many perpetrators spend hundreds if not thousands of dollars on illegal vehicle modifications, it is a step in the right direction.

Maui residents recently formed a group, with a particular focus on reducing vehicle noise. In addition to taking a toll on mental and physical health, these excessively loud vehicles are often correlated with reckless fast driving and higher exhaust pollution from their modified mufflers. Adequate fines should be part of the solution, although it will need to be combined with consistent law enforcement and proper vehicle safety inspections, both which have been woefully lacking.
