## TESTIMONY OF PHYLLIS SHIMABUKURO-GEISER CHAIRPERSON, BOARD OF AGRICULTURE

SENATE BILL NO. 2615 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE

Chairperson Gabbard and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on Senate Bill No. 2615 which establishes two positions on the Board of Agriculture ("Board") and specifies one shall be a resident of the island of Moloka`i and one shall be a resident of the island of Lana`i. The department supports the intent of the measure provided it does not adversely impact the Department's priorities in the Executive Supplemental Budget request.

It appears that this measure seeks to ensure representation of the of the Moloka`i and Lana`i agricultural communities on the Board by establishing positions that are geographically based. The Board was established with members from each of the four Counties to address that concern from its inception. Historically, the Board member representing Maui County has represented the interests of the entire county, including Moloka`i and Lana`i. Additionally, a member in one of the at-large positions on the board at this time is very knowledgeable of controlled environment agriculture on Lana`i which is an example of agricultural technology and innovation at its highest level in Hawai`i. The same member also has a diverse experience of agricultural production and food systems on the Island of Hawai`i. Currently any person as a resident of Moloka`i or Lana`i can also apply to be considered and nominated as an at-large member of the Board of Agriculture.

Within the department there is an exclusive opportunity for residents of Moloka`i to have a voice and decision-making vote as a member of the Moloka`i Irrigation System Water Users Advisory Board for the Moloka`i irrigation system water service. It has been a challenge for the department to fill vacant advisory board positions with Moloka`i residents. The department recently completed the 2020 Update to the Hawai`i



Statewide Agricultural Land Use Baseline that reported a significant increase in diversified crop acreage on Lana'i. In 2021, Moloka'i experienced specific challenges to animal disease and climate change. Adding two members of to the board of agriculture to represent Moloka'i and Lana'i provides the desired diversity in statewide representation of knowledge and perspectives for providing broad operating policies for the department.

Aloha Chair Gabbard, Vice Chair Nishihara, and Members of the Committee:

Pūlama Lāna'i is a land and resource management company, a cultural steward, and a community builder. Today, Lāna'i is being redefined as a sustainable community. Pūlama Lāna'i is helping to shape the future of our island by creating new opportunities driven by agriculture, resource management, conservation and more. We strive to enhance and perpetuate the island's diverse species and fragile ecosystem through game management, natural species preservation, watershed management, erosion control, coastal resources and fisheries management, invasive species control and conservation education. Pūlama Lāna'i brings an integrated and comprehensive approach to protect and manage Lāna'i's natural resources. Bound by a strong sense of community, we are committed to building infrastructure and expanding essential services to improve the lives of Lāna'i residents.

Pūlama Lāna'i is in **support of SB 2615**, which amends the current statute to establish a Board seat on the State of Hawai'i Department of Agriculture for the islands of Lāna'i and Moloka'i. Each island community has its own unique biocultural landscape, which recognizes the pervasive interactions between biological and cultural phenomena. As such, having a broad representation from each island will provide each island to have a voice at the table when establishing operating policies for the Department of Agriculture, which is dedicated to the preservation and productive use of agricultural resources so as to assure a healthy and adequate food supply for Hawaii's people, providing employment, maintaining a favorable balance of trade, and preserving the aesthetic quality of the Hawai'i.

As an asset manager for the ownership company, Pūlama Lāna'i is very interested in the policies that will govern agricultural resources on Lāna'i. Pūlama Lāna'i constructed a hydroponic operation on Lāna'i called Sensei Farms in 2020 and began exporting fresh produce to the residents and businesses as well as to the neighbor island market in the same year. Sensei Farms grows assorted greens and vine-grown vegetables more sustainably indoors with greater yields and a minimal footprint. The six greenhouses in production are powered by an off-grid solar and battery facility, further decreasing our agricultural operations dependence on fossil fuel and the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions. As we move forward to building a more sustainable future, policies that affect our island matter being part of the decision making process is vital.

We respectfully request that you favorably vote to move SB 2615 forward for consideration.
