S.B. 3292 RELATING TO THE SCHOOL FACILITIES AUTHORITY

Senate Committee on Education

The School Facilities Authority (SFA) **supports** this measure that proposes a process for the SFA board to provide a list of candidates to the governor for the executive director when the position has been vacant for 90 days.

The SFA enabling legislation does not include such a process for filling this important vacancy when the position is vacant for an extended term. The board welcomes this clarifying amendment.

The SFA also notes that at its regular meeting on February 3, 2022, the board established a permitted working group to initiate the candidate search for its first executive director.
