## Department's Position:

The Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) supports SCR 81 urging the prioritization of low- to moderate-income families for school bus transportation service.

The Department would need to pursue amendments to applicable Hawaii Administrative Rules to formalize, operationalize, and allow enforcement of this prioritization.

There are financial implications to the Department that will need to be addressed so as not to negatively impact programs that are funded by school bus pass fares such as City and County bus passes for students eligible for assistance under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, family mileage reimbursement, and other operational expenses.

The Department continues to work with our school bus contractors to hire qualified school bus drivers.
