BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

13	(2)	If a [corporation, organization, association, or labor
14		union, noncandidate committee that makes only
15		independent expenditures and has either received at
16		least one contribution of more than \$10,000 from any

By amending subsection (h) to read: "(h) This section shall not apply to any person who, 18 19 [prior to] before the commencement of proceedings under this section, has paid or agreed to pay the fines prescribed by 20 sections 11-340 and 11-391(b)." 21

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1	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3	begun before its effective date.
4	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.

Campaign Spending Commission Package; Fines; Noncandidate Committees; Independent Expenditures

Description:

Increases the fine that may be assessed for campaign spending law violations against a noncandidate committee making only independent expenditures and that has received at least one contribution of more than \$10,000, or spent more than \$10,000 in an election period. Allows the campaign spending commission to order that the fine be up to three times the amount of the unlawful contribution or expenditure, and that the payment of the fine assessed against a noncandidate committee, or any portion thereof, be paid from the personal funds of an officer of the noncandidate committee. Effective 7/1/2112. (HD1)
