

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) No person who is [under indictment for, or has waived
- 4 indictment for, or has been bound over to the circuit court
- 5 for, charged with a felony in a court in this State or
- 6 elsewhere, or has been convicted in this State or elsewhere of
- 7 having committed a felony, or any crime of violence, or an
- 8 illegal sale of any drug shall own, possess, or control any
- 9 firearm or ammunition therefor."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
