
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§26- Establishment of programs; reports. Any
5 department or agency that establishes a funded program in
6 accordance with an Act of the State shall submit a report on the
7 program to the legislature no later than one year following the
8 passage of the Act. The report to the legislature shall
9 include:

- 10 (1) All revenues, expenditures, and encumbrances for the
11 program;
12 (2) The number of employees hired to staff the program;
13 (3) If the program was implemented within the year in
14 which the enabling Act was passed; and
15 (4) Future plans for the program."

16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
