
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EARLY LEARNING BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302L-1.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The board shall consist of the following voting
4 members:

5 (1) A representative of center-based program providers or
6 the representative's designee;

7 (2) A representative of family child care program
8 providers;

9 (3) A representative of family-child interaction learning
10 program providers;

11 (4) A representative of philanthropic organizations that
12 support early learning or the representative's
13 designee;

14 (5) A representative from a head start provider agency;

15 (6) A representative from the Hawaii Early Intervention
16 Coordinating Council;

17 (7) A parent representative;



- 1 (8) A representative from the Hawaii chapter of the
- 2 American Academy of Pediatrics;
- 3 (9) A representative of home-visiting program providers;
- 4 (10) A representative of Hawaiian medium early learning
- 5 providers; and
- 6 (11) A representative of the Hawaii Council of Mayors, or
- 7 the representative's designee.

8 The superintendent of education, director of human
 9 services, director of health, [~~and~~] president of the University
 10 of Hawaii, and director of Hawaii P-20 Partnerships for
 11 Education shall serve as ex officio, nonvoting members of the
 12 board.

13 (c) Except for the superintendent of education, directors
 14 of state departments, president of the University of Hawaii,
 15 director of Hawaii P-20 Partnerships for Education, chief
 16 executive officer of Kamehameha Schools, and the executive
 17 director of the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools, or
 18 their designees, the members of the board shall serve staggered
 19 terms as follows:

- 20 (1) The representative of center-based program providers
- 21 shall serve a two-year term;



- 1 (2) The representative of family child care program
- 2 providers shall serve a three-year term;
- 3 (3) The representative of family-child interaction
- 4 learning program providers shall serve a three-year
- 5 term;
- 6 (4) The representative of philanthropic organizations that
- 7 support early learning shall serve a two-year term;
- 8 (5) The representative from a head start provider agency
- 9 shall serve a three-year term;
- 10 (6) The representative from the Hawaii Early Intervention
- 11 Coordinating Council shall serve a three-year term;
- 12 (7) The parent representative shall serve a two-year term;
- 13 (8) The representative from the Hawaii chapter of the
- 14 American Academy of Pediatrics shall serve a two-year
- 15 term;
- 16 (9) The representative of home-visiting program providers
- 17 shall serve a three-year term;
- 18 (10) The representative of Hawaiian medium early learning
- 19 providers shall serve a two-year term; provided that
- 20 the prohibition against serving more than two
- 21 consecutive terms not to exceed eight consecutive



1 years pursuant to section 26-34(a) shall not apply to
2 the representative of Hawaiian medium early learning
3 providers' term limit; and

4 (11) The representative of the Hawaii Council of Mayors
5 shall serve a three-year term."

6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.
