RELATING TO CESSPOOL CONVERSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 342D-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+]\$342D-72[+] Cesspools; mandatory upgrade, conversion, 4 or connection. (a) [Prior to] Before January 1, 2050, every 5 cesspool in the State, excluding cesspools granted exemptions by 6 the director of health pursuant to subsection (b), shall be: 7 Upgraded or converted to [a septic system or aerobic (1)8 treatment unit system;] a director-approved wastewater 9 system; or 10 (2) Connected to a sewerage system. 11 The director of health may grant exemptions from the (b) 12 requirements of subsection (a) to property owners of cesspools 13 that apply for an exemption and present documentation showing a 14 legitimate reason that makes it infeasible to upgrade, convert, 15 or connect the cesspools. For the purposes of this subsection, 16 a legitimate reason shall include but not be limited to: 17 (1)Small lot size:

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    underground geographic formation.

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    typically consists of a septic tank, piping, and a drainage
