# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is significant
- 2 benefit from substantial investment in high-quality early
- 3 learning programs. Extensive research affirms the positive
- 4 effects of high-quality early learning programs on outcomes for
- 5 young children. The legislature further finds that children who
- 6 have accessed such programs are more likely to succeed in
- 7 kindergarten, later in life, and well into adulthood.
- 8 Longitudinal studies have also indicated that children,
- 9 particularly those who come from disadvantaged backgrounds,
- 10 benefit from high-quality early learning programs. Furthermore,
- 11 research demonstrates that investments in early learning
- 12 programs yield economic benefits and reduce long-term social
- 13 costs.
- 14 Given the critical need to expand access to high-quality
- 15 early care and education programs for the benefit of the State's
- 16 children and their families, the purpose of this Act is to
- 17 appropriate funds to enhance the capacity and resources of the

3	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
4	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for	
6	the executive office on early learning, to be allocated as	
7	follows:	
8	(1)	\$ for one full-time (1.00 FTE) permanent
9		business management officer to facilitate, coordinate,
10		and monitor budgets and fiscal processes; and
11	(2)	\$ for one full-time (1.00 FTE) permanent
12		contract specialist to facilitate, coordinate, and
13		monitor contracts and the procurement process related
14		to the implementation of early learning programs and
15		services.
16	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
17	office on	early learning for the purposes of this Act.
18	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
