

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STUDENT TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
- 2 education provides regular bus service for qualified public
- 3 school students to facilitate compliance with the State's
- 4 compulsory attendance law and transportation of school children
- 5 law, as well as with federal law relating to the provision of a
- 6 free and appropriate education. According to the department of
- 7 education, the daily student ridership average for regular
- 8 education students is 35,090 students per day and 3,359 per day
- 9 for special education students. The legislature further finds
- 10 that school bus service provided by the department of education
- 11 is essential for getting students to and from school,
- 12 particularly for students who lack other transportation options
- 13 or face hardship in obtaining school transportation services due
- 14 to economic difficulty.
- 15 The legislature also finds that to qualify for regular
- 16 school bus service, students in grades K-5 must reside a mile or
- 17 more, and students in grades 6-12 must reside 1.5 miles or more,



- 1 from the school within their attendance area. Students who
- 2 qualify for school bus service may receive a free bus pass if
- 3 they meet eligibility requirements; or pay \$36.00 for quarterly
- 4 one-way trips, \$72.00 for quarterly round trips, or \$10.00 for
- 5 ten coupons. The legislature finds that a student who qualifies
- 6 for free lunch under the free and reduced price lunch program is
- 7 eligible for a free bus pass; however, free bus passes do not
- 8 extend to students who qualify for reduced lunch under the free
- 9 and reduced price lunch program. Students and families of
- 10 households who qualify for the reduced lunch price would benefit
- 11 from paying a school bus fare at a rate that is less than the
- 12 fare established by the department of education's administrative
- 13 rules.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 15 education to create a three-tiered student bus fare rate system
- 16 for the department of education's school bus program.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 302A-406, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 "§302A-406 Transportation of school children. (a) The
- 20 department may provide suitable transportation to and from

19	 	(2) shall pay the full rate for a bus pass.

- 2 91 governing the supervision and administration of the
- 3 transportation of school children under this section."
- 4 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
- 7 carry out the purposes of this Act.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 13 provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
