A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BIOSECURITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a recently concluded 2 five-year pilot program demonstrated that strengthening 3 biosecurity is a good investment for the State. Since invasive 4 species pose the biggest threat to Hawaii on many fronts, 5 preventive measures can save the State a significant amount of 6 money over the long term. Thus, it is important to ensure that 7 the biosecurity program can continue to operate and expand its 8 efforts. 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to continue 10 the ports-of-entry biosecurity program. 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for a 14 ports-of-entry biosecurity program; provided that the funds are

- 17 (2) \$ for materials and supplies;

allocated as follows:

1 (3) \$ for travel expenses; and
2 (4) \$ for all other costs.
3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
