
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "**§387-2 Minimum wages.** (a) Except as provided in section
4 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each
5 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less
6 than:
7 (1) \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003;
8 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006;
9 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007;
10 (4) \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015;
11 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016;
12 (6) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [~~and~~]
13 (7) \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018[~~-~~]; and
14 (8) \$18.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2023; provided
15 that this paragraph shall only apply to employers with
16 more than fifteen employees."


