A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SERVICE ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Daniel K. Inouye
- 2 International Airport is the only port of entry for all dogs and
- 3 cats entering Hawaii unless a valid neighbor island inspection
- 4 permit has been issued by the Hawaii department of agriculture.
- 5 This requirement encompasses all dogs and cats, including
- 6 service animals. The legislature further finds that because the
- 7 airport animal quarantine holding facility is located on Oahu,
- 8 the animal inspection fee for service animals is waived for
- 9 those who arrive at the Daniel K. Inouye International Airport.
- 10 Residents and visitors who arrive at any other port of entry in
- 11 the State with a service animal are burdened with having to pay
- 12 the inspection permit fee.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to provide equality and fairness
- 14 to all disabled persons traveling with a service animal by
- 15 waiving the inspection fee for all service animal owners
- 16 entering the State, regardless of the port of entry.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 142, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§142- Service arimals; interisland quarantine; permit
5	fees. The department shall be responsible for all neighbor
6	island inspection permit fees for a service animal, as defined
7	in section 347-2.5, that is located in the State and is being
8	transported for release at Kona, Kahului, or Lihue airports."
9	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
