9		stored regulated substances for the operational life
10		of the tank or tank system;
11	(2)	The material used in the construction or lining of the
12		tank or tank system is compatible with the substance
13		to be stored; [and]
14	(3)	Existing underground storage tanks or existing tank
15		systems shall be replaced or upgraded not later than
16		December 22, 1998, to prevent releases for their
