
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$99,010,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 seventh representative district, as follows:

7 1. Kipapa Elementary School

8 Design and construction for a covered
9 play court.

10 Design \$900,000

11 Construction \$2,100,000

12 Total funding \$3,000,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.


10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project

12 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
15 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
16 of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
