BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 353, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 5 committed person confined in a state correctional facility in
 6 execution of a sentence imposed upon the committed person shall
- 7 not be released prior to completion of the committed person's
- 8 sentence except as provided by part II of this chapter or by
- 9 reason of the committed person's terminal illness.
- (b) For purposes of this section, "terminal illness" means
 11 a progressive and incurable medical condition that is expected
- 12 to result in death."
- 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
