1 WHEREAS, as an island nation in the middle of the Pacific Ocean, New Zealand faces some of the same geographic challenges 2 as Hawaii and has taken steps in protecting its environment and 3 4 expanding its economy; and 5 WHEREAS, a relationship between Hawaii and New Zealand 6 would also be highly beneficial in expanding and diversifying 7 Hawaii's film industry, enhancing Hawaii's educational quality 8 and opportunities, developing and meeting Hawaii's environmental 9 goals, and developing and bolstering Hawaii's exportable 10 commodities; and 11 12 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 229-3, Hawaii Revised 13 Statutes, the Hawaii Sister-State Committee is tasked with 14 evaluating and developing recommendations for the initiation of 15 all sister-state relationships and forwarding its 16 recommendations to the Legislature for implementation by either 17 18 adoption of a concurrent resolution or enactment of session law to that effect; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 21 22 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Sister-State 23 24 Committee is requested to evaluate and develop recommendations 25 to initiate a sister-state relationship between Hawaii and the 26 city of Auckland, New Zealand; and 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Sister-State 28 Committee report its findings and recommendations for further 29 action related to initiating a sister-state relationship between 30 Hawaii and the city of Auckland, New Zealand, including any 31 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty 32 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2023; and 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 35 36 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; and Chairperson of 37 the Hawaii Sister-State Committee. 38 39 40 OFFERED BY: Ce CE 41 MAR 1 1 2022
