HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS TO IMPROVE SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, sidewalks are integral components of the State's streets and roadways; and

WHEREAS, many residents rely on sidewalks for exercise, recreation, and transportation; and

WHEREAS, sidewalks increase pedestrian safety by separating pedestrians from vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, unmaintained and undermaintained sidewalks may cause pedestrian injuries and hinder residents, especially elderly residents and those residents having mobility impairments, from properly using the sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, proper maintenance of sidewalks in the City and County of Honolulu is crucial to the health and well-being of the residents of, and visitors to, Honolulu; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the Senate concurring, that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to convene a working group to develop recommendations to improve sidewalk maintenance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following individuals are requested to serve as members of the working group:

(1) The Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, or the Mayor's designee;
