WHEREAS, health care providers in Hawaii increasingly rely 1 2 on real-time audio and visual telehealth visits and other 3 modalities of care delivery to increase access to health care in 4 the State; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic placed severe restrictions on in-person gatherings and meetings, 7 thereby increasing the need for remote modalities of health care 8 9 delivery; and 10 WHEREAS, telehealth is a valuable method of health care 11 12 delivery that requires further discussion and evaluation to determine whether its use can ensure quality health outcomes for 13 patients, by specialty care area, and the appropriate health 14 15 insurance coverage levels for these services; and 16 WHEREAS, there is an additional need to remedy digital 17 health disparities for individuals who lack access to the audio-18 visual technology needed for telehealth visits; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, other remote care modalities, such as audio-only 22 telephonic services, are a valuable method of health care delivery; and 23 24 25 WHEREAS, audio-only telephonic services are not currently considered telehealth services; and 26 27
