WHEREAS, from a cultural heritage standpoint, it's the State's duty and obligation to honor the legacy of the school that had educated and instilled the traditions and pride into all students and alumni, and especially to the men who volunteered and enlisted as soldiers to the war efforts of World War II; and

 WHEREAS, the name McKinley High School will memorialize these remains, many of whom are laid to rest at the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific overlooking McKinley High School, and for those who were buried on foreign land and never returned home; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the Senate concurring, that the Superintendent Education is emphatically urged to request the Board of Education to preserve the name of McKinley High School and its rich history to honor the legacy of its alumni, the "Greatest Generation", for their loyal service and ultimate sacrifice during World War II; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Hawaii's Congressional delegation, Governor, Chairperson of the Board of Education, Superintendent of Education, Kaimuki-McKinley-

Roosevelt Complex Area Superintendent, and President of the McKinley High School Foundation.
