A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§302A- Board of education; open forums. At any public
- 5 meeting properly noticed pursuant to chapter 92, the board of
- 6 education shall include an open forum at the end of its meeting
- 7 agenda to afford all interested persons an opportunity to
- 8 present oral testimony on any matter not on the agenda; provided
- 9 that the testimony is related to matters over which the board of
- 10 education has supervision, control, jurisdiction, or advisory
- 11 power."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1106.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 13 is amended to read as follows:
- "§302A-1106.5 Board of education; community [meetings.]
- 15 forums. [The board shall hold not less than one community
- 16 meeting annually in each county in In addition to [their] its
- 17 regular meetings, the board shall hold not less than six

1	community forums annually to discuss and receive input from the		
2	community on public education and public library issues $[-]$;		
3	provided that the board shall hold at least one community forum		
4	in each county. The board chairperson shall designate less than		
5	a quorum of board members to attend [the] each community		
6	[meetings.] forum. These community [meetings] forums shall not		
7	be held for the purpose of formulating educational policy. The		
8	community [meetings] forums shall be [exempt from sections		
9	92-2.5, 92-7, 92-9, and 92-41; provided that the board shall		
10	give written public notice of each community meeting. The		
11	meeting notice shall indicate the date, time, and place of the		
12	meeting, and shall be filed in the office of the lieutenant		
13	governor and in the board's office for public inspection six		
14	calendar days before the meeting. The notice shall also be		
15	posted at the site of the meeting.] a permitted interaction		
16	under section 92-2.5; provided that:		
17	(1) The board shall give a written public notice that		
18	indicates the date, time, and place of each community		
19	forum; provided further that the notice shall be		
20	subject to the same posting and filing requirements of		
21	board meeting notices, pursuant to section 92-7(b);		

Ţ	(2)	Community forums shall be open to the public and all
2		persons shall be permitted to attend; provided further
3		that the removal of any person or persons who wilfully
4		disrupt a community forum to prevent and compromise
5		the conduct of the community forum shall not be
6		prohibited;
7	(3)	The board shall afford all interested persons an
8		opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, in
9		writing or in person, on any public education or
10		public library issues at each community forum;
11	(4)	No commitment relating to a vote on a matter is made
12		or sought at any community forum; and
13	(5)	At the next duly noticed meeting of the board, the
14		board members shall report their attendance and the
15		matters presented and discussed at the community
16		forum."
17	SECT	ION 3. The board of education shall report to the
18	legislatu	re no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
19	the regula	ar session of 2023 on its efforts to amend its policies
20	to include	e an open forum at the end of its meeting agenda to

- 1 afford all interested persons an opportunity to present oral
- 2 testimony on any matter not on the agenda.
- 3 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Report Title:

Board of Education; Community Forums; Public Meetings; Oral Testimony; Open Forums

Description:

Requires the Board to include an open forum for public comments on non-agenda items at the end of board meetings. Requires the Board of Education to hold not less than six community forums annually, with at least one forum in each county. Requires a report to the Legislature on implementing open forums. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD2)
