A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 142, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§142- Beehive; swarm; disposition. (a) Any person
5 that receives state or county funds who wishes to remove a
6 beehive or swarm from that person's property shall contract with
7 a beekeeper or pest control operator for the removal of the
8 beehive or swarm. Destruction of the beehive shall only occur
9 as a last resort when all other methods are ineffective or
10 unavailable.

11 (b) As used in this section:

12 "Person" shall include any private entity and any agency of
13 the State or any of its political subdivisions.

14 "Pest control operator" has the same meaning as in section
15 460J-1."

16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.


