## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 342L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part II to read as follows:
- 3 "§342L- Inspections of tanks and tank systems; required.
- 4 (a) Beginning on July 1, 2022, the owner or operator of an
- 5 underground storage tank or tank system shall have each
- 6 underground storage tank and tank system inspected at least
- 7 annually to determine compliance with section 342L-32, which
- 8 requires tanks and tank systems be designed, constructed,
- 9 installed, upgraded, maintained, repaired, and operated to
- 10 prevent releases of the stored regulated substances for the
- 11 operational life of the tank or tank system, and other standards
- 12 that are consistent with the protection of human health and the
- 13 environment, including spill and overfill prevention and
- 14 corrosion protection. Each inspection must be performed by an
- 15 inspector qualified to perform the inspection in accordance with
- 16 rules adopted by the department, and must include, as
- 17 applicable, examination, assessment, testing, and documentation
