A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATIVE HAWAIIAN REHABILITATION PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The department of public safety, in
- 2 collaboration with the office of Hawaiian affairs, shall create
- 3 a rehabilitation program for Native Hawaiian prison inmates with
- 4 an emphasis on preserving Native Hawaiian values and cultural
- 5 practices.
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 9 the establishment of a Native Hawaiian rehabilitation program
- 10 for prison inmates based on Native Hawaiian values and cultural
- 11 practices.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Department of
- 13 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
