A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATIVE HAWAIIAN REHABILITATION PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 353, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§353- Native Hawaiian rehabilitation; program. The
- 5 department, in collaboration with the office of Hawaiian
- 6 affairs, shall create a rehabilitation program for Native
- 7 Hawaiian prison inmates that has an emphasis on preserving
- 8 Native Hawaiian values and cultural practices."
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 12 the establishment of a Native Hawaiian rehabilitation program
- 13 for prison inmates that is based on Native Hawaiian values and
- 14 cultural practices.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Department of
- 16 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
