1	is a medical emergency in the area. A male correctional
2	facility employee shall not enter into an area prohibited under
3	this subsection if there is a female correctional employee who

7	when entering a housing unit.
8	(c) If a male correctional facility employee conducts a

Requires PSD to increase its recruitment and training of female adult corrections officers and address certain concerns, federal requirements, and staffing shortages. Requires PSD to submit a report on its efforts. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2)
