BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	" <pre>S141- Healthy soils program; special fund;</pre>		
5	<u>establish</u>	ed. (a) The department of agriculture shall establish	
6	a healthy	soils program, which shall:	
7	(1)	Create a statewide soil health assessment with a list	
8		of practices specific to the State and that are most	
9		effective in improving soil health and building soil	
10		carbon stocks;	
11	(2)	Provide farmers with education and technical	
12		assistance to implement farm management practices that	
13		contribute to healthy soils;	
14	(3)	By, establish standards that shall apply to	
15		the healthy soils program and be based on the findings	
16		of the greenhouse gas sequestration task force	
17		established pursuant to section 225P-4 relating to	



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1		minimum levels of soil carbon and water content and
2		required soil health practices; and
3	(4)	Subject to available funding, issue awards and other
4		financial incentives to implement farm management
5		practices that contribute to healthy soils.
6	(b)	The long-term goals of the healthy soils program shall
7	be to establish:	
8	(1)	Deadlines by which all awards issued by the department
9		of agriculture shall meet the standards established
10		pursuant to subsection (a)(3);
11	(2)	Deadlines by which a plan for all state lands leased
12		for agricultural use shall be required pursuant to the
13		healthy soils program; and
14	(3)	Programs incentivizing small farmers, ranchers, and
15		landowners to take carbon positive actions on their
16		respective lands.
17	(C)	There is established a healthy soils program special
18	fund to b	e administered by the department of agriculture and
19	<u>into whic</u>	h shall be deposited moneys appropriated by the
20	legislatu	re. The special fund shall be used to implement and
21	operate t	he healthy soils program and issue awards.

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1 (d) The department of agriculture shall submit a report 2 detailing the status and progress of the healthy soils program 3 and its recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to 4 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening 5 of each regular session." 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general fund 7 the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary 8 for fiscal year 2022-2023 to be deposited into the healthy soils 9 program special fund. 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the healthy soils 11 program special fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the 13 establishment of the healthy soils program and to issue awards 14 pursuant to the program. 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 16 agriculture for the purposes of this Act. 17 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
