BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

facilitate the intent of this section;

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1 Employ persons exempt from chapters 76 and 89; (9) 2 (10) Provide centralized computer information management 3 and processing services, coordination in the use of 4 all information processing equipment, software, 5 facilities, and services in the executive branch of 6 the State, and consultation and support services in 7 the use of information processing and management 8 technologies to improve the efficiency, effectiveness, 9 and productivity of state government programs; 10 Establish, coordinate, and manage a program to provide (11)11 a means for public access to public information and 12 develop and operate an information network in conjunction with overall plans for establishing a 13 14 communication backbone for state government; and 15 (12)Adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 91, necessary for the 16 purposes of this part." 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
