A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that grant writing can be 2 time-consuming and complex. While significant public and 3 private funding is available that could benefit the State's 4 families and communities, state agencies may lack the technical 5 expertise to successfully apply for and manage grants. 6 Additionally, failure to accurately interpret detailed grant 7 requirements may lead to problematic compliance issues. The 8 legislature finds that state agencies are best positioned to 9 pursue and manage grants and other public and private funding 10 opportunities when one dedicated individual is responsible for 11 overseeing them.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of human services and department of health to appoint an existing employee to apply for and manage grants, request grant writing assistance from other state agencies, or contract or employ a dedicated capture manager for this purpose.

SECTION 2. (a) The department of human services may:

12	(2)	Apply for grants and other public or private funding;

14	(3)	Manage all grants awarded to the department.
15	(c)	The capture manager may be retained as:
16	(1)	A contractor exempt from chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised
17		Statutes; or
18	(2)	A temporary employee exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii
19		Revised Statutes.
20	(d)	The department of human services shall submit reports
21	to the le	gislature no later than twenty days prior to the



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1 convening of the regular sessions of 2023 and 2024. The reports 2 shall include: 3 (1) A list of any grants or funding opportunities sought 4 or applied for; 5 (2) A list of grants awarded and public or private funding 6 received; and 7 (3) Any recommendations or proposed legislation. SECTION 3. (a) The department of health may: 8 Appoint an existing department employee and afford the 9 (1) 10 employee time during regular business hours to apply 11 for and manage grants or other public or private 12 funding; Request grant writing assistance from other state 13 (2) 14 agencies as appropriate; or 15 Contract the services of or employ an individual to (3) serve as a capture manager for the department. 16 If a capture manager is contracted or employed, the 17 (b) 18 capture manager shall: Serve as a dedicated grant writer for the department; 19 (1)Apply for grants and other public or private funding; 20 (2) 21 and


