## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BIOSECURITY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a recently concluded
- 2 five-year pilot program demonstrated that strengthening
- 3 biosecurity is a good investment for the State. Since invasive
- 4 species pose the biggest threat to Hawaii on many fronts,
- 5 preventive measures can save the State a significant amount of
- 6 money over the long term. Thus, it is important to ensure that
- 7 the biosecurity program can continue to operate and expand its
- 8 efforts.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for fiscal
- 10 year 2022-2023 for a ports-of-entry biosecurity program.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$525,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for a
- 14 ports-of-entry biosecurity program; provided that the moneys
- 15 appropriated shall be allocated as follows:
- 16 (1) \$425,000 for personnel costs;
- 17 (2) \$60,000 for materials and supplies;
- 18 (3) \$15,000 for travel expenses; and
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- 1 (4) \$25,000 for all other costs.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 3 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
