A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BIOSECURITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a recently concluded
- 2 five-year pilot program demonstrated that strengthening
- 3 biosecurity is a good investment for the State. Since invasive
- 4 species pose the biggest threat to Hawaii on many fronts,
- 5 preventive measures can save the State a significant amount of
- 6 money over the long term. Thus, it is important to ensure that
- 7 the biosecurity program can continue to operate and expand its
- 8 efforts.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for fiscal
- 10 year 2022-2023 for a ports-of-entry biosecurity program.
- 11 SECTION 2. Out of the general revenues of the State of
- 12 Hawaii that are appropriated for native resources and fire
- 13 protection programs (LNR 402), there is appropriated the sum of
- 14 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 15 year 2022-2023 for a ports-of-entry biosecurity program;
- 16 provided that the moneys appropriated shall be allocated as
- 17 follows:



(1) \$ for personnel costs; 1 (2) \$ for materials and supplies; for travel expenses; and 3 (3) \$ (4) for all other costs. 4 \$ 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 6 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
