
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BIOSECURITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a recently concluded
2 five-year pilot program demonstrated that strengthening
3 biosecurity is a good investment for the State. Since invasive
4 species pose the biggest threat to Hawaii on many fronts,
5 preventive measures can save the State a significant amount of
6 money over the long term. Thus, it is important to ensure that
7 the biosecurity program can continue to operate and expand its
8 efforts.

9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for fiscal
10 year 2022-2023 for a ports-of-entry biosecurity program.

11 SECTION 2. Out of the general revenues of the State of
12 Hawaii that are appropriated for native resources and fire
13 protection programs (LNR 402), there is appropriated the sum of
14 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
15 year 2022-2023 for a ports-of-entry biosecurity program;
16 provided that the moneys appropriated shall be allocated as
17 follows:



- 1 (1) \$ for personnel costs;
- 2 (2) \$ for materials and supplies;
- 3 (3) \$ for travel expenses; and
- 4 (4) \$ for all other costs.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
6 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
