A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§356D-Landlord incentive program special fund; 5 (a) There is established in the state treasury established. 6 the landlord incentive program special fund into which shall be 7 deposited all appropriations made by the legislature to the 8 special fund, grants, gifts, and interest on moneys therein. 9 The landlord incentive program special fund shall be (b) 10 administered by the authority. Moneys in the special fund shall 11 be used to reimburse land owners who participate in the section 12 8 housing choice voucher program to cover repair costs of 13 tenant-caused property damage when the repair costs exceed the 14 tenant's security deposit." 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and



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the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 1 2 year 2022-2023 to be deposited into the landlord incentive 3 program special fund. 4 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the landlord 5 incentive program special fund the sum of \$ or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and the 7 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the landlord incentive program. 8 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii 10 public housing authority for the purposes of this Act. 11 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021. 13
